

Accessing Consumer Reports from the Library website:

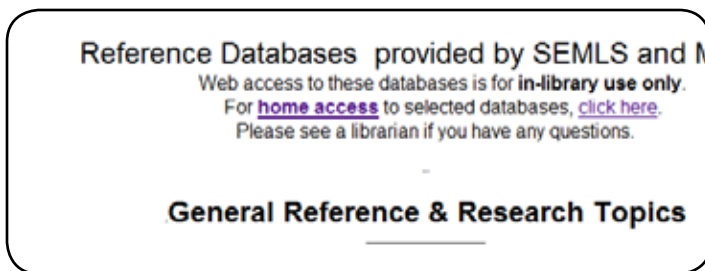
1) Click the Catalog link under our edgartownlibrary.org logo at the top of the page.



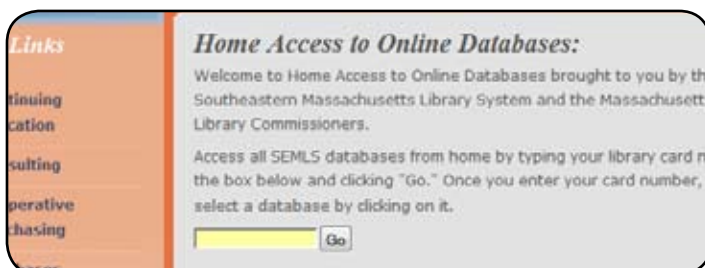
2) In the CLAMS window that opens, look along the right side for two boxes. In the lower box, choose Reference Databases.



3) Toward the top of the page that opens, click on "home access."



4) On the next page that opens, enter your library card number.



5) Now you are finally into the databases. On this page, choose Infotrac One File (it has a logo toward the center of the window)



6) In the blue menu bar near the top of the page, select Publication Search.



7) In the Publication Search window that opens next, type in Consumer Reports and hit the search button. The first item that comes up in the next list will be the magazine. You can choose an edition to browse, or at top left on that screen, you can search within Consumer Reports.
